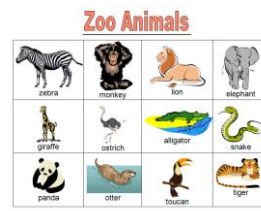


ASDAN -Animal care short course

The course is for Young people of all abilities, mainly aged between 13 and 19 (as well as adults and younger learners, where appropriate).

Because Short Courses are multi-level, the focus is on completing challenges and skills development according to individual ability, rather than attainment at a specific level.

The Short Course is split into seven modules, each containing activities based around a different aspect of animal care:

- Animal Investigation
- Safety Around Animals
- Looking After Animals
- Animals in Trouble
- Animals in the Media
- Animals and the Law
- Careers in Working with Animals



ASDAN - Environmental Short course

The Environmental Short Course has been developed in partnership with [Eco-Schools](#) and accredits up to 60 hours of involvement in various environmental activities, whether through Eco-School or other environmental initiatives and projects.

Short Courses are multi-level, the focus is on completing challenges and skills development according to individual ability, rather than attainment at a specific level.

The Short Course is split into four sections:

- Environmental Review
- Raising Awareness
- Planning and Doing
- Managing and Monitoring

Both courses link to further accreditation through. This counts as a possible 12 credits towards a CoPE qualification (Certificate of Personal Effectiveness)
