



## Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award

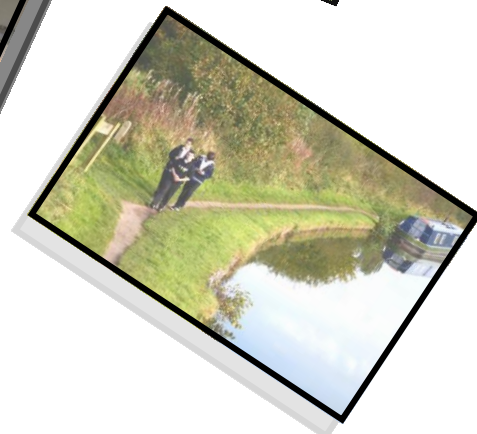
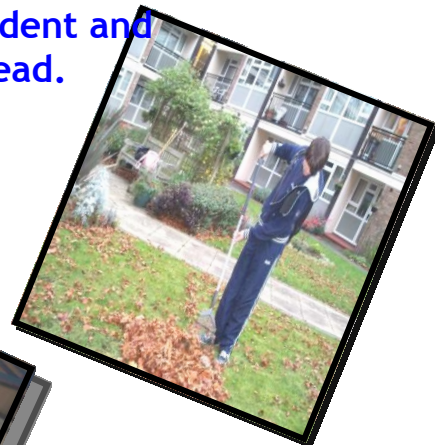


If your son or daughter is accepted onto this course. They will be given all the training they need in order to achieve the award.
