Manor College also offers the 'Bridging the Gap' project at year 13.

This project is based at Manchester Metropolitan University and other schools. This project gives students the opportunity to take part 3 extended work placements, building on their employability skills and enhancing their prospects within employment.

At Manor College we expect students to commit to high standards through their approach to learning and behaviour. Students are encouraged to participate within the wider school environment through school council, mentoring programme, whilst acting as positive role models to the younger students.
