The BTEC Construction course is offered to years 10,11 and can be continued at a higher level in Manor College.

Pupils who undertake the BTEC in Construction course will achieve their qualification by successfully completing the required number of units.

Pupils will undertake a wide variety of work related tasks ranging from practical based skills such as **Bricklaying**, **Carpentry and Building Maintenance Skills**. It will also include assessments on creating tasks, planning and communication skills. Pupils will also experience what it is like to work as part of a team.

The BTEC Construction course offers a range of experiences through a wide and varied range of work related assignments.

Young people who undertake this course will be provided with a range of practical work related experiences. This will enable them to undertake some practical repairs and tasks in and around the home e.g. simple plumbing and patch plastering. This will enhance a young person's life skills and chances of further training and employment.
